3. AIM AND OBJECTIVES:

The main aim of this study was to evaluate the pattern of motion stereotype of the Bengali (Indian) population and to promote the application of motion stereotypic data in man-machine interface design.

The followings are the main objectives of the study:

- 1. To prepare a database on motion stereotypic responses of Bengali (Indian) population.
- 2. To form data base on colour stereotypic responses of Bengali (Indian) population
- 3. To study the impact of the rural-urban variation, adult-children variation and gender difference in motion stereotypic responses of the population.
- 4. To evaluate the impact of some factors like handedness, educational and socio-economic status
- 5. To study the impact of spatial (three dimensional) arrangement of controls on motion stereotypic responses.
- 6. To study the impact of work related cardiovascular stress, work related psychological stress and heat stress on motion stereotypic responses.
- 7. To apply the motion stereotype of the studied population for modification in the design of interface between gas burner and the users.
