- 1. The proceedings of the last DC meeting held on 12.11.2021 is read and confirmed.
- 2. The matter of syllabus change in PG level in Applied Mathematics is discussed with the DC members. All members have requested the HOD to call a separate DC meeting taking only this issue in the first week of January, 2022 and in that meeting it will be discussed elaborately.

The theme of this seminar will be 'Contribution of Indian Mathematicians: Pre and Post-Independence of India'. Primarily, following four (4) speakers would be invited to deliver talk in this seminar.

 - (c). Prof. Goura
 - (d). One Professor from Calcutta University- That will be decided by HOD.
- 5. The matter of Internal Assessment has been discussed with all the DC members. After having opinion of all the DC members; it is decided that the 1st internal assessment of 1st& 3rd Semester, 2021 will be executed offline in four days as follows. 2nd Internal Assessment of these semesters will be decided later on the basis of COVID 19 situation at that time depending upon the guideline of the University.
