Agenda 2: Introduction to new best practices and updates on existing ones.

**Resolutions:** Professor Debdulal Banerjee appraised the house about existing best practices like Maintaining Green Campus; No AC Day; No Vehicle Day; Archiving Tribal Language; Paperless-Automation in financial and academic activities and transactions; Transparency in the activities of statutory bodies etc.

Proposal for replacing 'no vehicle day' by observing Cycle Rally, Poster Rally, Patha Natika etc. was placed before the house. After thorough discussion it is resolved that existing practice of 'no vehicle day' will be continued along with the proposed programmes to increase environmental awareness among the students. It is also resolved that more toto will be arranged and parking facility will be increased to minimise the difficulties of the university employees.

Agenda 4: Proposal to introduce registration of each research scholar for every semester.

Resolution: Resolved that after plagiarism check, a certificate will be issued to the candidate for attachment in the thesis. House requested Prof. Madhumangal Pal to prepare the draft format of this certificate.

Agenda 7: Proposal to introduce token appreciation to the faculty members based on their research publications in reputed journals.

Resolution: Professor Madhumangal Pal placed a proposal for token appreciation to the faculty members, with certificate and memento, based on their research publications in
