The following resolutions are taken unanimously:

- 1. The resolutions of the last DC meeting dated 12.12.2024 are confirmed.
- Regarding Agenda 1, the Convenor of the Conference, Prof. Sebak Kumar Jana, briefed the status of the Activity Report, Income-Expenditure statements, Audit Report and Utilization Report of the said conference. The members discussed on these four documents and suggested the Convenor to submit all to the ICSSR at the soonest.
- 3. Regarding Agenda 2, the members resented on the irregular class attendance by some of the students of Semester I and agreed to meet the students to overcome the problem. Also under the same Agenda, the members fixed up the dates for Internal Assessment I and Internal Assessment II for Semester I. The dates for Internal I are 13.01.2025 (Papers ECO 101 & 102), 15.01.2025 (Papers ECO 103 & 104) and 16.01.2025 (Paper ECO 105). - 4.
